A shuttle will be waiting to take you to the conference hotel* in the city center. On arrival in Upington your transport will be waiting to take you to the Augrabies National Park. A light lunch will be <u>optional</u> at the camp cafeteria. After lunch, there will be time to view the majestic Augrabies Waterfall and to take a drive down to the canyon viewpoint.
